Procedural minima have now been set for gynecologic oncology fellowships. The Accreditation Data System (ADS) will be updated by August 1, 2025, and the new minimum numbers will be in effect immediately; however, they will not be enforced until review of the 2027 graduate data to give programs time to acclimate. While it is not anticipated that programs will have difficulty meeting the new minimum numbers, any challenges should be addressed in the Major Changes and Other Updates section of the ADS Annual Update.
